Visitor Code of Conduct

To ensure a positive guest experience, we ask all guests to adhere to the following rules:

- Food or drink are not allowed in the exhibition spaces or near vehicles and artifacts.
- Do not cross barriers or enter restricted areas. Touching or physical contact with the Museum's collection is prohibited.
- Entering Museum exhibition spaces without proof of admission (paid or otherwise) is prohibited.
- Children under the age of 13 must be accompanied by an adult while inside the Museum.
- Service animals are welcome throughout the Museum campus. Under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), a service animal is defined as a dog that has been individually trained to do work or perform tasks for an individual with a disability. Pets and emotional support animals are not permitted.
- Costumes, including masks that cover the face, are not permitted at any time.
- During your visit, areas within the Museum may be closed for maintenance, construction, exhibit development, or special events. We strive to keep the Museum galleries accessible to guests during business hours as much as possible.
- No smoking or vaping inside of the building or in non-designated outside areas.
- Drones are prohibited on the Museum's campus, over buildings, parking lots, and pedestrians without prior approval. Flights may face additional restrictions during events. To request Drone Flight Authorization, contact the National Corvette Museum's security team.
- Guests are welcome to take personal photography in our galleries unless otherwise noted. Please, no flash, tripods, or selfie sticks. We encourage our guests to share photos online and tag @corvettemuseum.
- During your visit, the National Corvette Museum and/or the media may take photos or videos to be used by the Museum or its designees. If you are photographed at the Museum, your image may be used without your prior consent and without compensation on any media, including websites, brochures, flyers, blogs, and social media sites.
